Picture Walk Check List for K-3

- 1. Direct students to preview the cover and each page prior to reading.
- 2. Have students make predictions about each page.

Ask students:

- 3. What do you see on the cover?
- 4. What do you think this person is doing (next page or successive pages)?
- 5. Who are the other characters?
- 6. What are other characters doing in the story?
- 7. What do you think this story is about?
- 8. What do you think will happen next?
- 9. Next?
- 10. In the end?

Picture Walk Check List for 4-8

- 1. Direct students to preview the back cover. Read the blurb to them.
- 2. Have students make predictions about the blurb and any other quotes.
- 3. Read students the first page or two and ask them to make a prediction.
- 4. Quote what a character (or two) says and ask what they think they're doing.

Ask students:

- 5. Who are these other characters and what is their role in this story?
- 6. Review vocabulary words they might struggle with, or terms specific to the story.
- 7. Have them make predictions based on specific vocabulary words.
- 8. Ask: What do you think this story is about?
- 9. Ask: What are some important things you think happen?
- 10. Ask: What might happen in the end?
