Penultimate - A place for hand-written notes on an iPad. Evernote - The Swiss Army knife of iPad apps. Students can use Evernote for a little bit of everything from bookmarking websites to dictating self-notes. The app will automatically sync with students online Evernote accounts. Feedly - Takes RSS subscriptions and lays them out in a nice magazine style format that makes it easy to quickly scan headlines and images attached to articles. Three Ring is a fantastic, free service for digitizing and organizing students' physical work. Quick Key is an app that turns your iPhone (it also works on iPad) into a bubble sheet scanner using two parts to it that when combined, make it very easy to quickly grade multiple choice and true/false quizzes. Pinterest for iPad app - A board started for this blog.

[Haiku Deck](#) - An iPad app that enables anyone to create beautiful slide presentations. Haiku Deck intentionally limits how much text that one can put on each slide.
